Asset Forfeiture Reporting Program 2025 Annual Report

The New York State Division of Criminal Justice Services (DCJS) is statutorily required to publish an annual report detailing the value and distribution of assets seized as a result of criminal proceedings in the state, pursuant to the state's Civil Practice Laws and Rules (CPLR) Article 13-A and Penal Law Article 480.

Claiming authorities, typically district attorneys' offices, and claiming agents, typically police departments and sheriffs' offices, are required to report to DCJS the value of assets seized and the distribution of those assets under a specific formula outlined in CPLR 13-A.

In most instances, forfeiture actions are initiated by claiming authorities. Upon conclusion of a case, asset forfeiture proceeds are distributed to claiming authorities, claiming agents and the state Office of Addiction Services and Supports (OASAS).

State law permits local officials to use forfeiture proceeds to fund investigations and prosecutions, reimburse agencies for the purchase of contraband during an investigation and pay restitution, among other expenses. The law does not require agencies to report to DCJS how they spent asset forfeiture funds they received.

In 2025, claiming authorities and claiming agents reported that more than \$16 million was forfeited and distributed pursuant to state laws. In addition, claiming authorities and claiming agents reported more than \$7 million was collected pursuant to federal forfeiture statutes.
