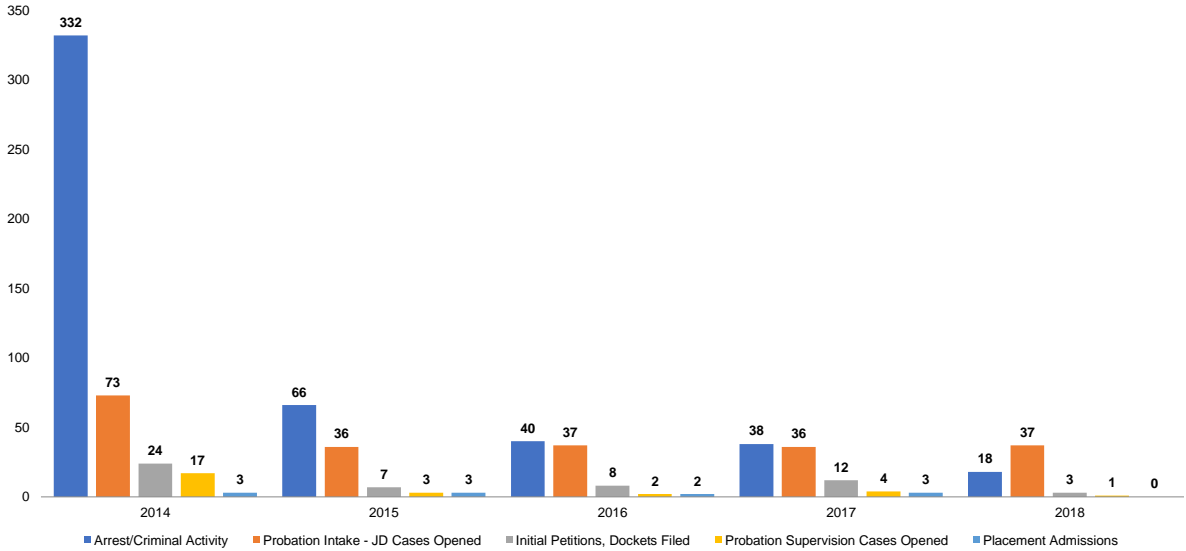


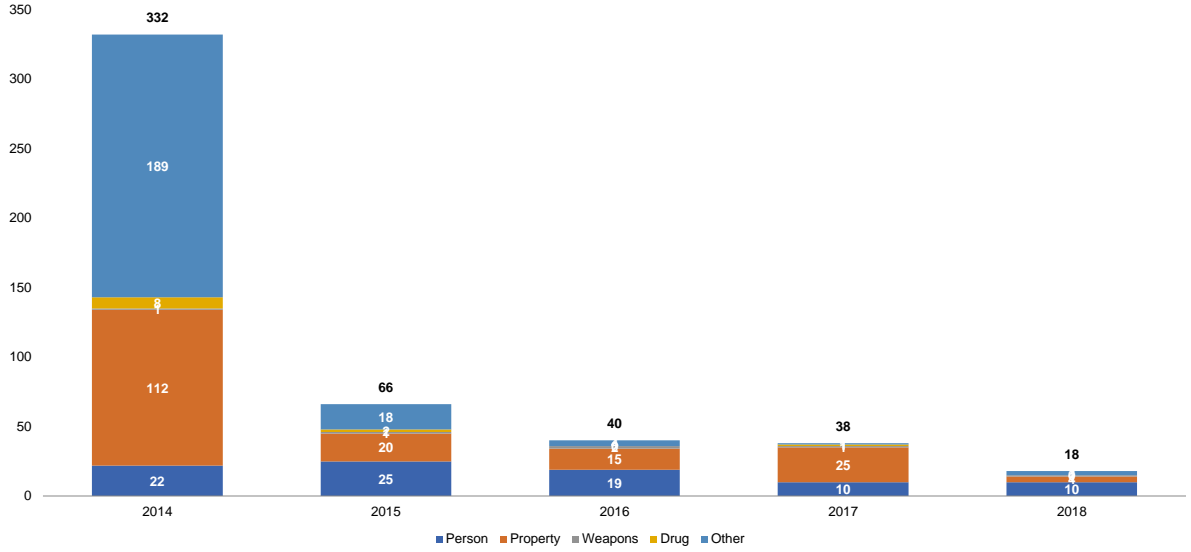

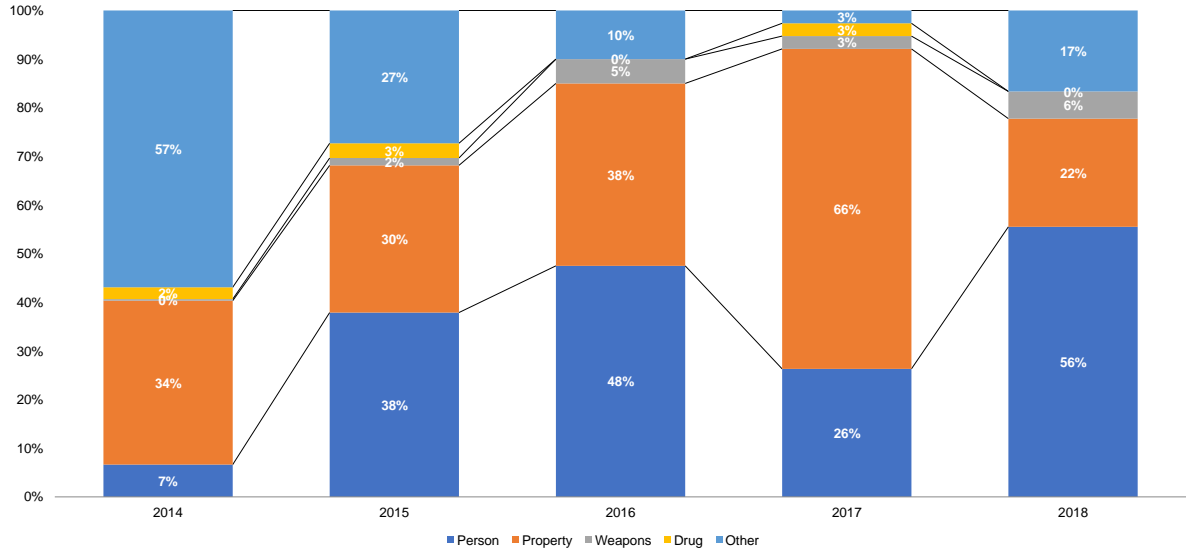


Arrests by Crime Type (Number)

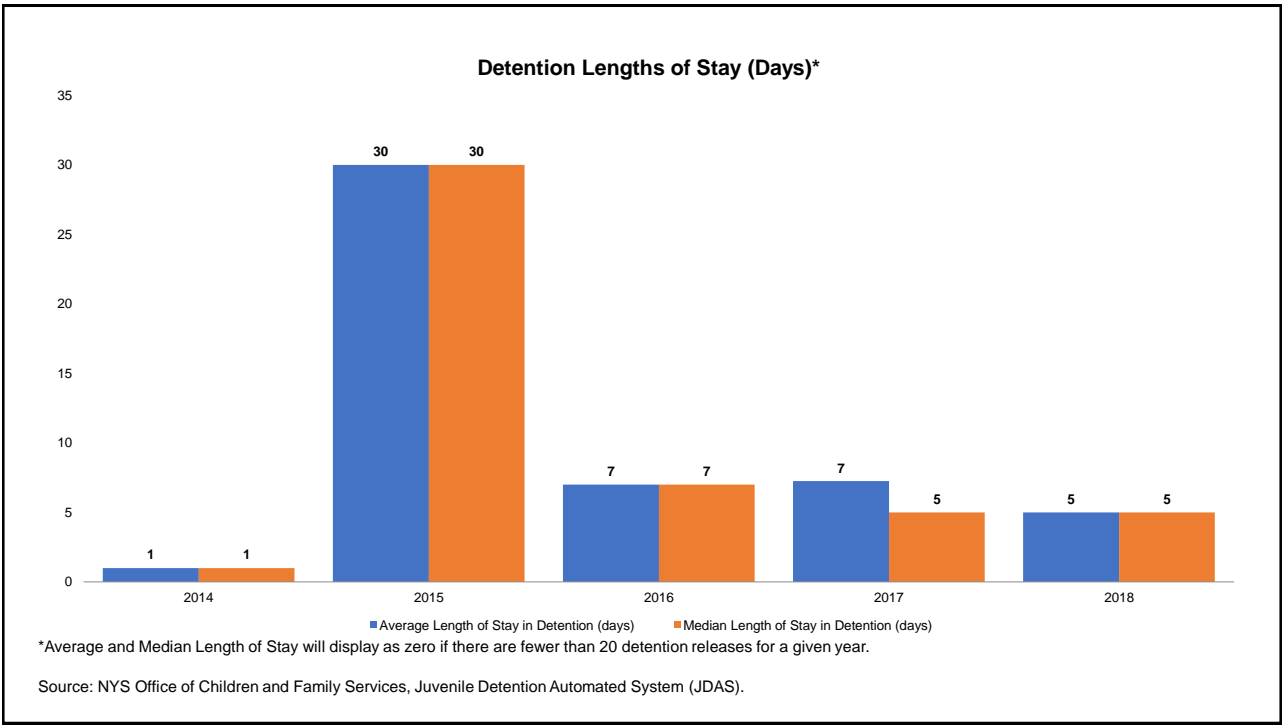
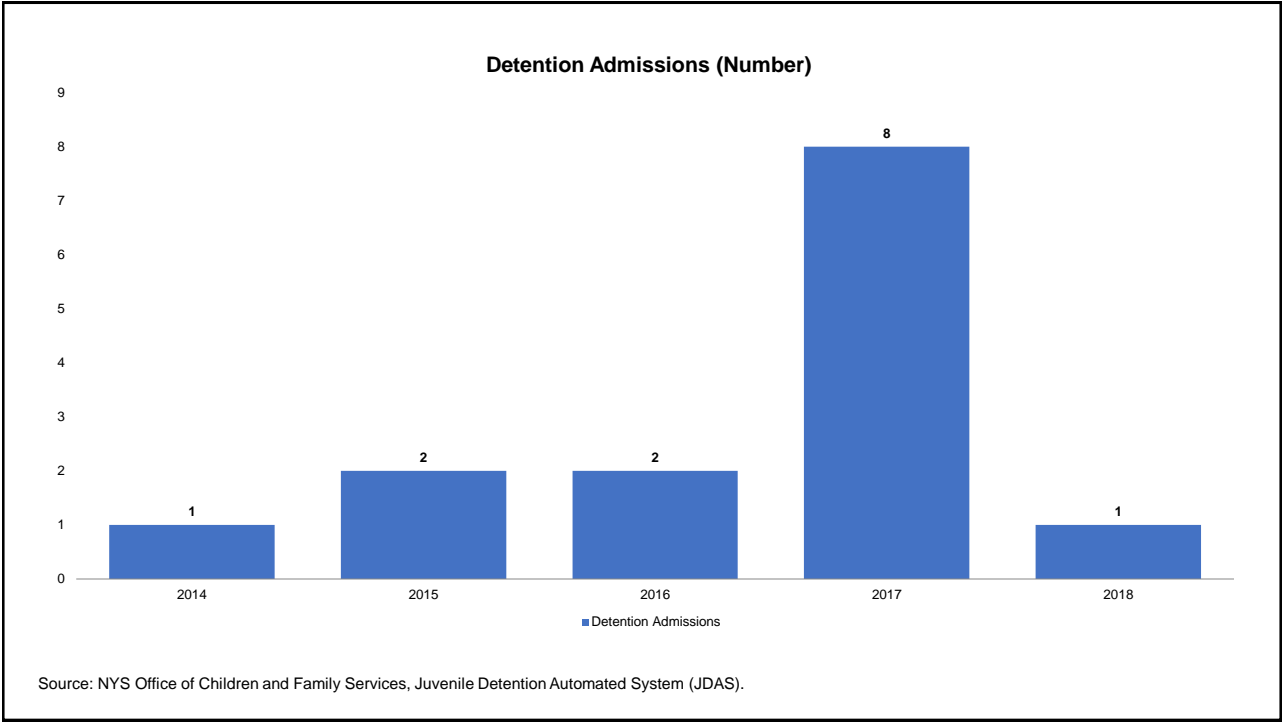


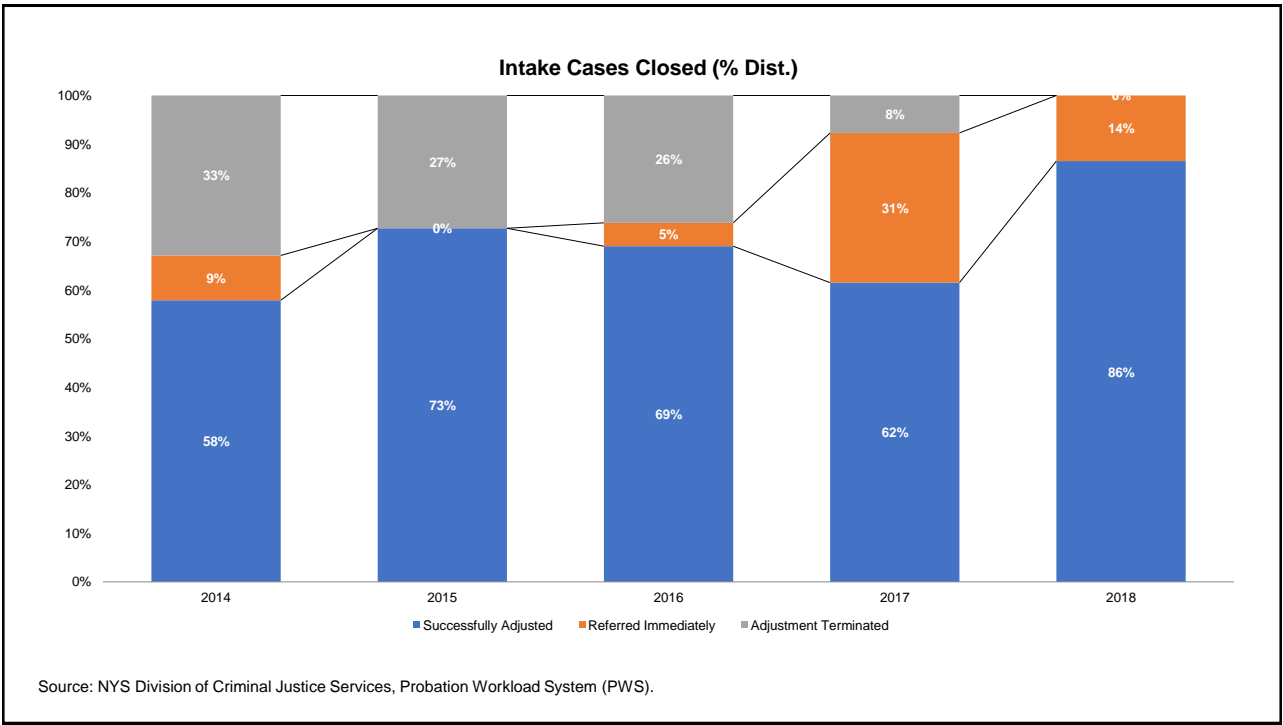
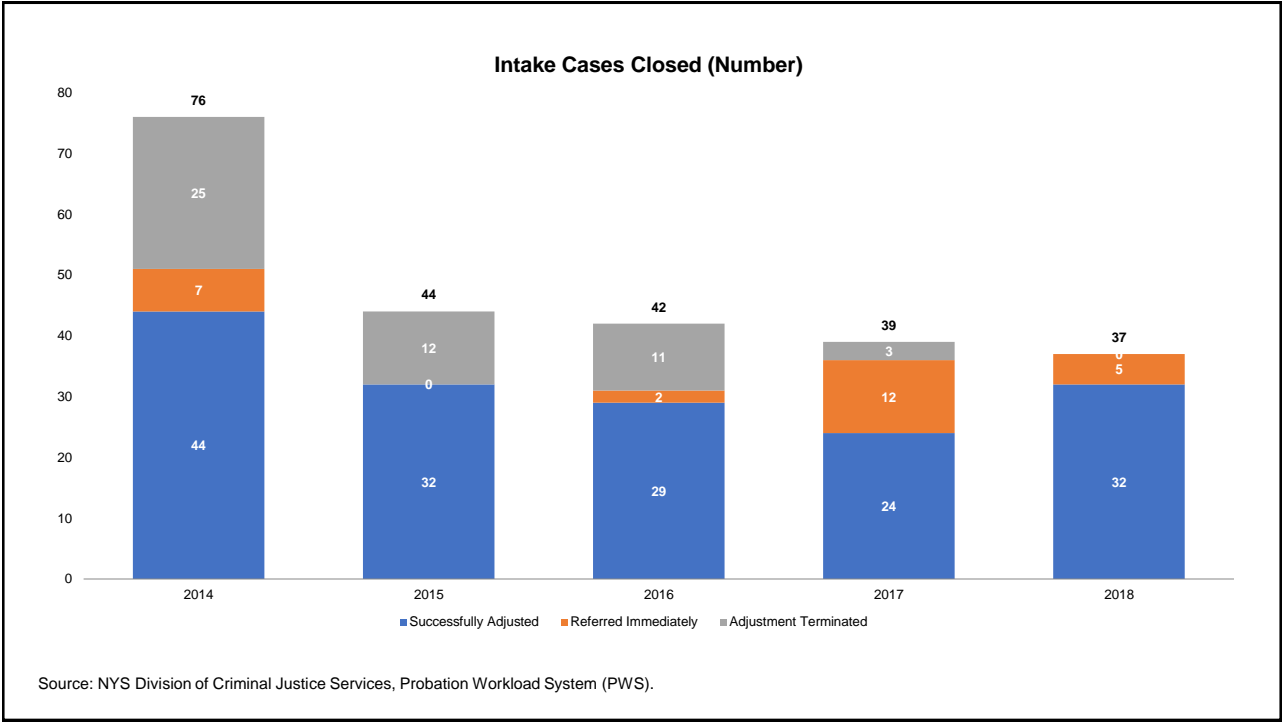

Arrests by Crime Type (% Dist.)

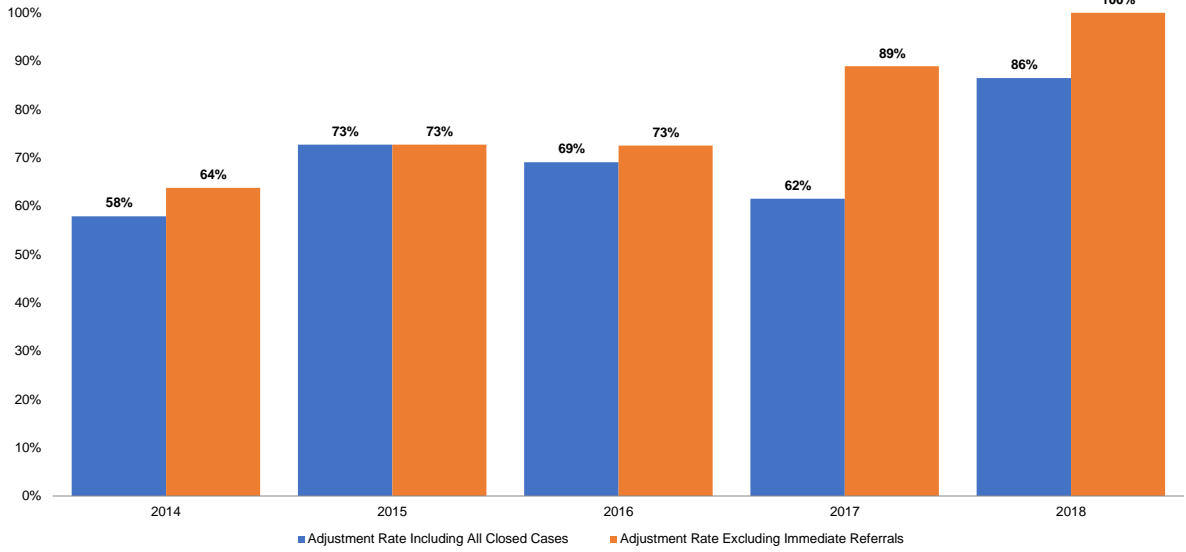

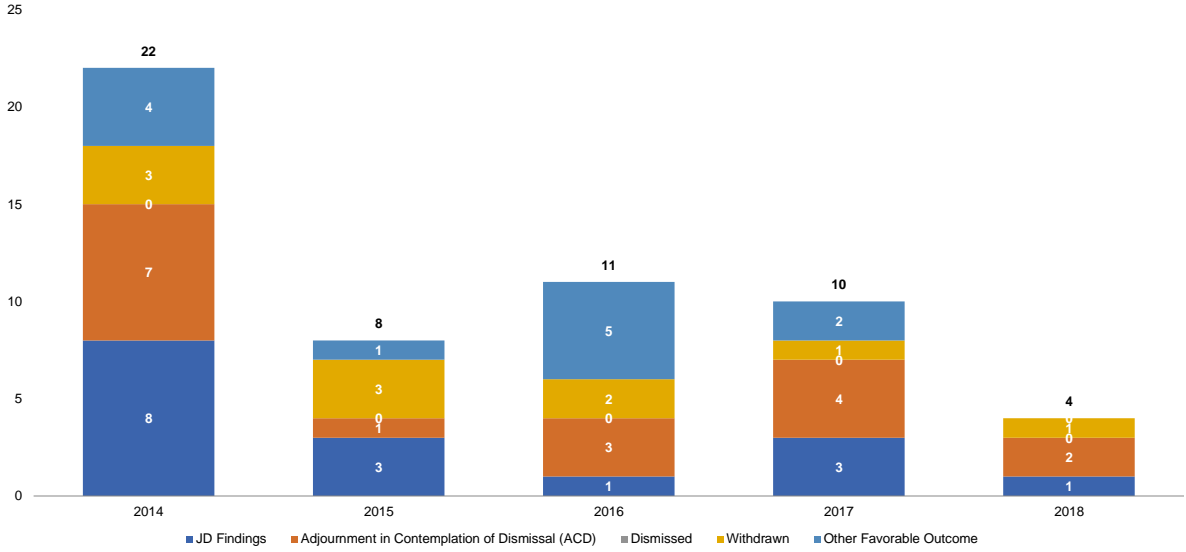
Intake Cases Adjusted (Adjustment Rates)

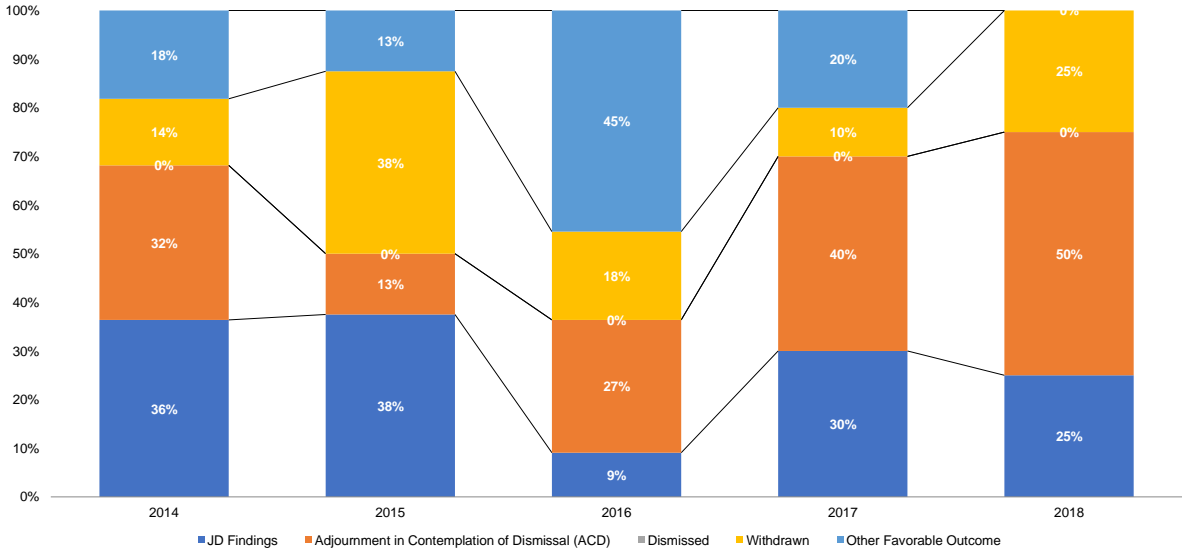


Initial JD Petitions Disposed (Number)



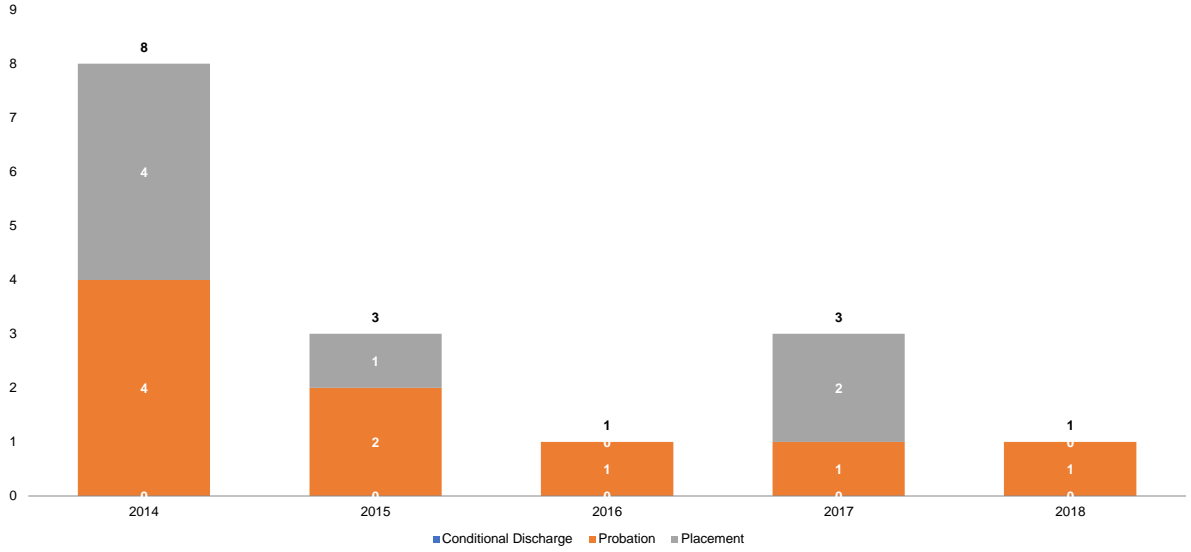

Initial JD Petitions Disposed (% Dist.)



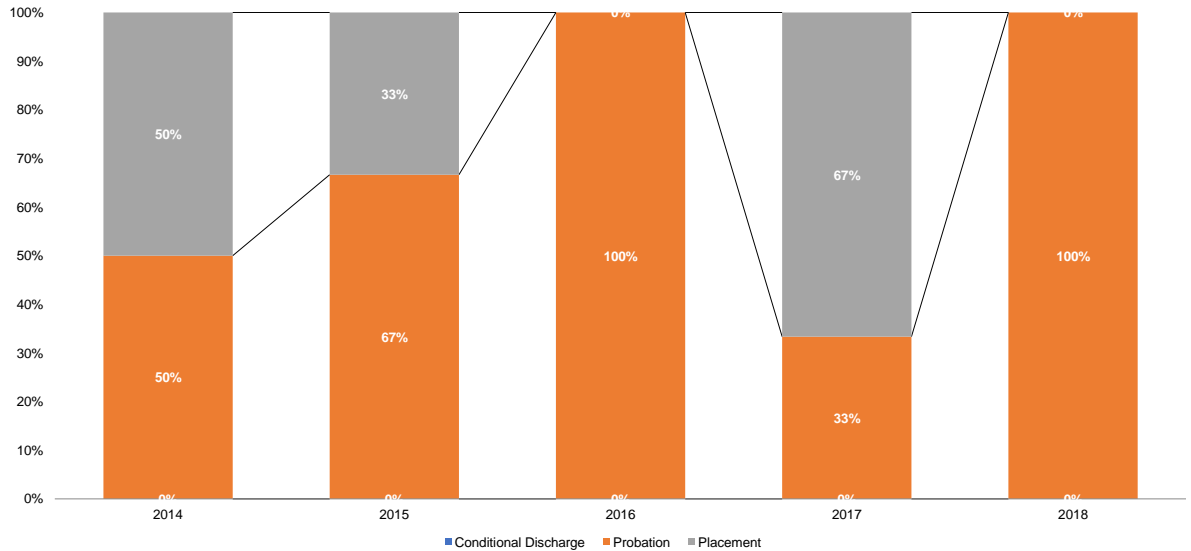

Initial JD Petitions Disposed with JD Findings (Number)



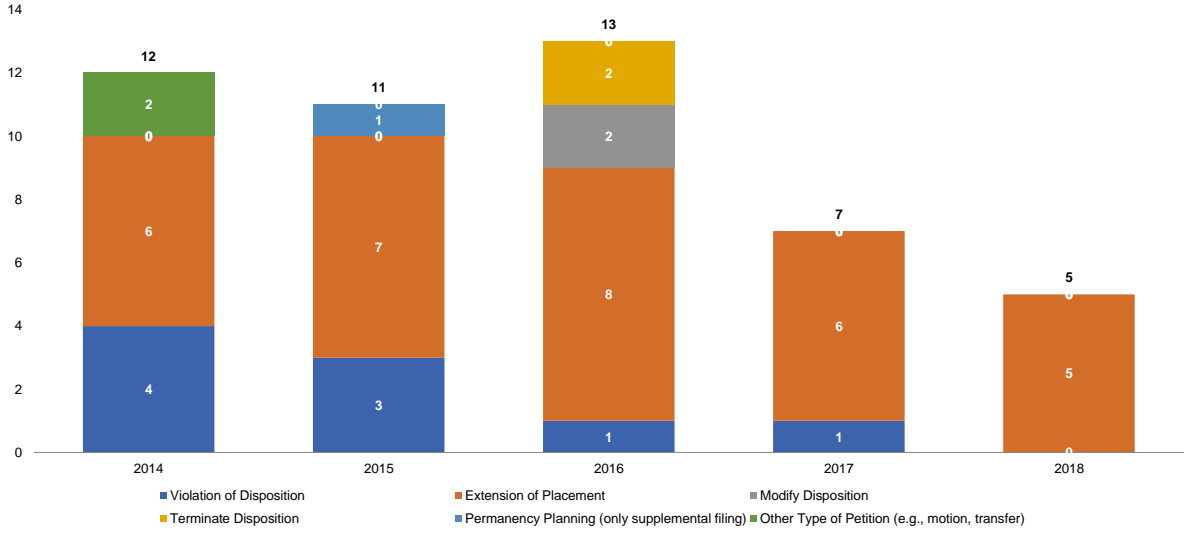

Initial JD Petitions Disposed with JD Findings (% Dist.)



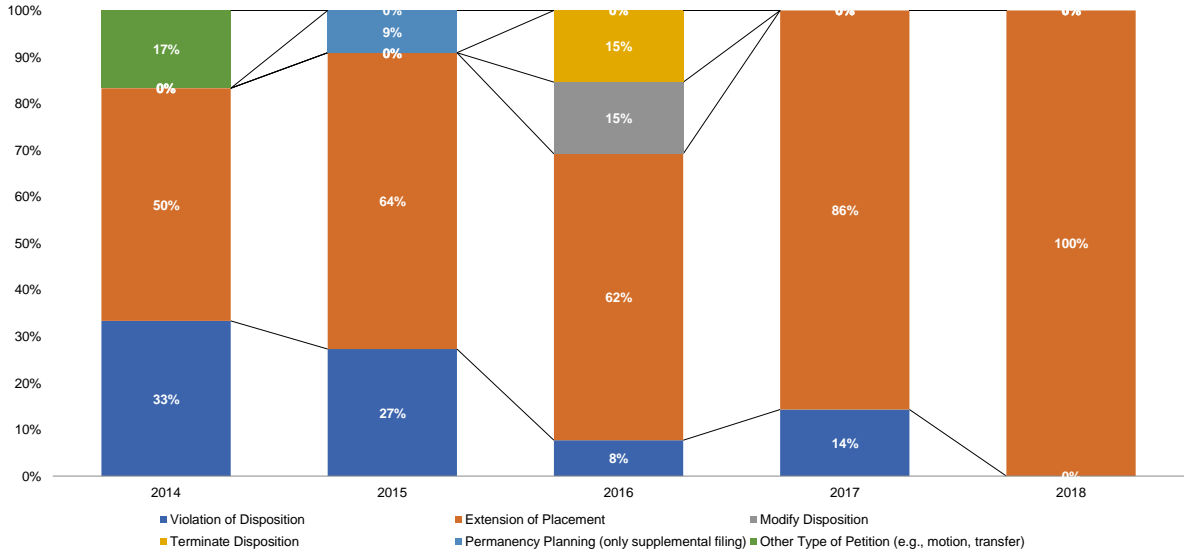
